MEDIA SPECIFICATIONS/LIMITATIONS:

2-D must be under 40” in width. 3-D must be able to fit on a wall shelf approximately 10” deep x 18” high”; on a pedestal 24” each direction or smaller; or self-standing floor pieces.

Music, written poetry or prose, can be performed at opening or closing reception. Please inform committee members of instrument & length of musical piece. Optional: provide a printed written version of the music or writing for display.
